BOARD MEETING MINUTES

November 19, 2019

CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Long Reach Board of Directors was called to order by Nina Basu, at 7:33 pm Tuesday, November 19, 2019 in the Martin Luther King Jr. Conference Room, at Stonehouse. Friedman motioned to approve the purchase of a portable bar replacement, with the understanding that it will be depreciated over 10 years, up to \$3500. Seconded. Approved 4-0-0
