The Howard County Stormwater Management Division is working on a capital project to repair the outlet structure for the eastern of the three ponds in the Sewells Orchard development. This repair is required due to the poor condition of the existing metal outlet structure.

We had planned on proceeding to construction this Summer/Fall but we have put the construction of this project on hold until we can further develop the design as well as explore several other concepts that would reduce the environmental impact to the pond ecosystem while still meeting the project goals.

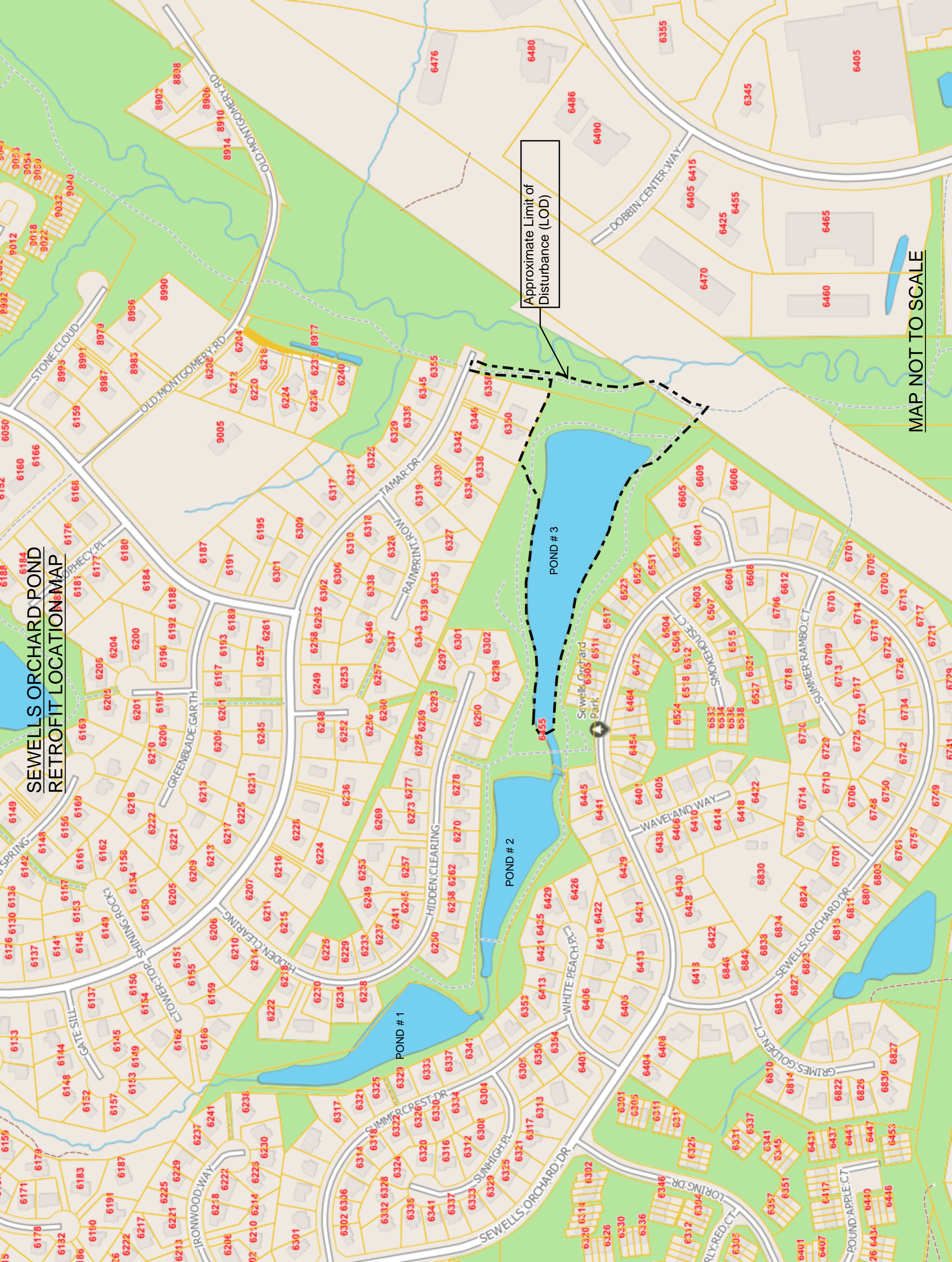
